RULES OF PLAY (4x4) FOR SAND VOLLEYBALL LEAGUES:

- IN 4X4 PLAY, YOU MUST ROTATE THE SERVER BUT YOU DO NOT HAVE TO ROTATE YOUR POSITION ON THE COURT.
- YOU CANNOT "TIP", IF YOU JUMP TO ATTACK THE BALL, YOU MUST CONTACT THE BALL WITH YOUR PALM, KNUCKLES, OR FIST
- NET SERVES- SERVES THAT HIT THE TOP OF THE NET AND GO OVER ARE IN PLAY
 JUST LIKE ANY OTHER TIME DURING THE MATCH. IF THE BALL DROPS ON THE OPPOSING
 COURT, IT IS A POINT FOR THE SERVING TEAM.
- IT IS LEGAL IN SAND VOLLEYBALL TO CONTACT THE BALL WITH YOUR FOOT. IT COUNTS AS A HIT THE SAME AS ANY OTHER PART OF YOUR BODY.
- YOU CANNOT BLOCK OR ATTACK A SERVE.

ALL GAMES ARE PLAYED TO 21 POINTS (RALLY SCORING). EACH TEAM WILL PLAY 3
GAMES REGARDLESS OF WINNING OR LOSING THE FIRST 2 GAMES.
THERE ARE NO REFS, ALL CALLS HAVE TO BE MADE BY THE TEAMS PLAYING. IF A CALL IS
QUESTIONABLE, REPLAY THE POINT.

 THE WINNING TEAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR TURNING IN SCORES. A SCORESHEET IS KEPT ON THE TABLE BY OUR FRONT DOOR TO RECORD SCORES.
