RULES OF PLAY FOR SAND VOLLEYBALL LEAGUES:

- COED TEAMS MUST HAVE AT LEAST ONE GIRL AND CANNOT PLAY WITH MORE THAN
 3 GUYS AT ANY TIME. IT IS OK TO PLAY WITH MORE GIRLS THAN GUYS.
- MAKE SURE YOUR GAMES START ON TIME. IF YOU PLAY ON ONE OF THE EARLIER LEAGUES (6:30 OR 7:40), CENTERLINE WILL CALL A TIME LIMIT ON YOUR MATCH 5 MINUTES INTO THE NEXT SET OF GAMES. FOR EXAMPLE, YOU PLAY AT 6:30, WE WILL ANNOUNCE AT 7:45 THAT GAMES MUST STOP REGARDLESS OF SCORE SO THE NEXT LEAGUE CAN START PLAYING.
- "SERVE RULE"- FOR COED REC LEAGUES, AFTER SCORING ON 3 CONSECUTIVE PLAYS, THE NEXT SERVE MUST BE UNDERHAND, THEN YOU CAN GO BACK TO "3 OVER, 1 UNDER". THERE IS NO SERVE RULE FOR INTERMEDIATE AND COMPETITIVE LEAGUES.
- NET SERVES- SERVES THAT HIT THE TOP OF THE NET AND GO OVER ARE IN PLAY
 JUST LIKE ANY OTHER TIME DURING THE MATCH. IF THE BALL DROPS ON THE OPPOSING
 COURT, IT IS A POINT FOR THE SERVING TEAM.
- IT IS LEGAL IN SAND VOLLEYBALL TO CONTACT THE BALL WITH YOUR FOOT, IT COUNTS AS A HIT THE SAME AS ANY OTHER PART OF YOUR BODY.
- YOU CANNOT BLOCK OR ATTACK A SERVE.
- ALL GAMES ARE PLAYED TO 21 POINTS (RALLY SCORING), BUT YOU MUST WIN BY 2.
 THERE ARE NO REFS, ALL CALLS HAVE TO BE MADE BY THE TEAMS PLAYING. IF A
 CALL IS QUESTIONABLE, REPLAY THE POINT

THE WINNING TEAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR TURNING IN SCORES. A SCORESHEET IS KEPT ON THE TABLE BY OUR FRONT DOOR TO RECORD SCORES.
